	<p>Spring semester:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3rd year of Bachelor (Licence 3): 2nd week of January to end of March Internship period beg. of April to end of June <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exams: 1st week of April • Resit sessions: end of June - 1st year of Master (Master 1): mid-January to mid-June <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exams: last week of March and between March and June (during the courses) • Resit sessions: beg. of July - 1st year of EMBS (Master 1): beginning of February to end of June <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exams: during the semester and at the end of the semester <p><i>If the teacher and the home university agree, the student could resit in his/her home university (same date and time as the French students) in order to avoid coming back to France in July.</i></p> <p>International Semester in Management:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Classes: beginning of September to mid-December. Given in blocks of one week every two weeks (second week is used to work on a project) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exams: during the semester. <p>There are no resit sessions since all the courses are given in blocks and there is no final exam period.</p>

<i>Main language of instruction</i>	<p>French – B2 level is required to attend classes in French If the student has B1 level when applying, he/she needs to attend the integration week as well as the French course during the semester</p>

<i>Can undergraduate students take courses in the postgraduate curriculum?</i>	We recommend that students choose all their courses in the same department and level there is a highly probability that courses will clash in their timetable and during the exam period if they don't.

<i>Language courses offered to exchange students</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Courses during integration week (late August) - Courses during fall semester (3 levels) - Courses during spring semester (number of groups will depend on the number of students attending the course)

<i>Is accommodation offered to exchange students?</i>	<p>Yes, students have to fill in a form when they apply online. There are 4 or 5 different residences are available. It depends on how much the student can pay.</p> <p>https://www.univ-smb.fr/fileadmin/Dri/moveon/Residences_Annecy.pdf</p> <p>Rent is usually between 400 and 550€ depending on the type of accommodation. Students living in a residence can benefit from a housing benefit from the French government (between 100€ and 230€/month).</p>
<i>Estimated cost of living per month</i>	<p>Around 600€</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bus: 23€ per month or 54€ for 3 months - Food: 200€ - Housing insurance: about 40€ for 1 year
<i>Do exchange students require particular insurances (e.g. health insurance)?</i>	<p>There is no fee if the students have the European Health Card Insurance, non-European students can benefit from coverage from the French system.</p> <p>16€ for the civil liability (compulsory for all students)</p> <p>Students might need a supplementary health insurance with their EHIC since only 70% of any medical act is refunded in France. They can apply upon arrival (first price is 11€/month)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Price of a medical consultation is 25€
